Edible Garden Trail 7th & 8th March

The Edible Garden Trail stretches from Blaxland to Hartley and includes 8 gardens in Mt Victoria, Blackheath and the Megalong Valley.

This is a rare opportunity to be invited in to many public and private local gardens to explore how food is being grown both for humans and for wildlife.

Thanks to funding received from the Edible Garden Trail last year,

Blackheath Community Farm has been able to establish a Compost Lab with worm farms and a range of different composting strategies. The Farm will be running Compost Lab Tours at 11am on each day of the Edible Garden Trail.

At Mt Victoria, Vanessa McGarrigle will be providing home-grown/made treats in a mini garden cafe over the weekend. You'll definitely see more than just plants on the Trail - there are chooks, ducks, rabbits, sheep, alpacas, bees, worms and lots of insects.

The Trail is a great opportunity to explore how gardeners have coped with drought, fires and flood and continued to produce healthy local food and habitat to support biodiversity.
